10 years and over	DAY CAMPS	1:18 (1:10 For All Water Activities and Rec Sports and field trips. For field trips also meet 1:10 ratio plus minimum of two adults)
6 & under	RESIDENTIAL CAMPS - ALL	1:4 (For field trips meet ratio plus minimum of two adults)
Age 7-17	RESIDENTAIL CAMPS - GENERAL	1:10 (For field trips meet ratio plus minimum of two adults)
Age 10-17*	RESIDENTAIL CAMPS - CLASSROOM SETTING & TRANSITIONAL SITUATIONS*	1:18 *Must have another adult staff member(s) on duty at the camp during these times to call upon and respond within 5 minutes if assistance is needed.
