

USCIS Fee Increases Effective 30 July 2007

The US Citizenship and Immigration Services office has announced that they will be increasing the processing fees for all of their forms filed on or after 30 July 2007. The fees for the forms most commonly used by UW-Madison will be:

I-129 Petition for Nonimmigrant Worker (H-1B, O-1, TN): \$320

I-140 Petition for Immigrant Worker: \$475

I-539 Extend Stay as Nonimmigrant or Change Nonimmigrant Status: \$300

I-765 Employment Authorization Document: \$340

I-485 Adjustment of Status to Permanent Resident: \$1,010

NOTE: The fee for the I-485 now includes the fee for the I-131 Application for Advance Parole and the I-765 Application for Employment Authorization Document (EAD), as well as the biometrics (fingerprinting) fee. The full fee must be paid, whether or not the applicant wishes to obtain Advance Parole and/or an EAD.
